In the late 1990s, Master P released full-on narrative films with the same titles as his albums, which were somehow fictional masters of Lemonade with some seriously ensnared dialogue. This new series is a glimpse of a world where this practice has caught on with the entire music industry. The series, created by Parisian artistic director David Redon, features posters in a blessing style for songs and albums by Amy Winehouse, 2Pac and Jay-Z. (Before that, Redon stunned musicians with vintage ads.) Some are thematically suited, like the galactic, scary Pyramid of Frank Ocean, while others would no doubt make their namesake as excited as Lauryn Hill's misjudgment turned into a bikini bank booty.
